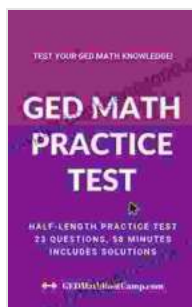

 $A = 25\pi \text{ cm}^2$

3. What is the probability of rolling a 6 on a standard six-sided die?

$$1/6$$

There are six possible outcomes when rolling a die: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6. Since there is only one way to roll a 6, the probability of rolling a 6 is  $1/6$ .

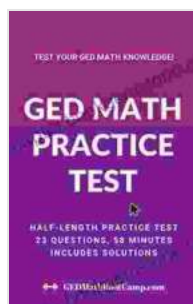
Here are some tips for success on the GED Math test:

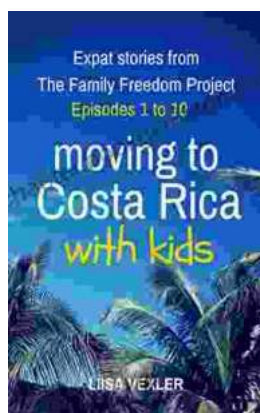

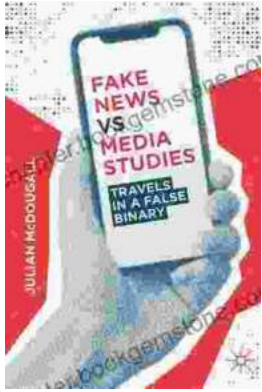
