

The HBS Admissions Process

The HBS admissions process begins with the submission of an online application. The application requires you to submit a variety of materials, including your transcripts, test scores, resume, and essays. You will also need to submit two letters of recommendation.

The application deadlines for the HBS MBA program are as follows:

Round 1: September 7, 2022

Round 2: January 5, 2023

Round 3: April 11, 2023

The HBS Admissions Committee

The HBS Admissions Committee is composed of a group of faculty members, administrators, and alumni. The committee is responsible for evaluating applications and making admissions decisions.



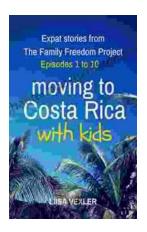
