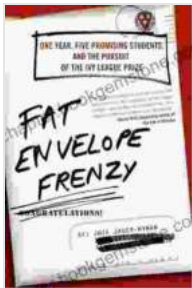


One Year, Five Promising Students, and the Pursuit of the Ivy League Prize

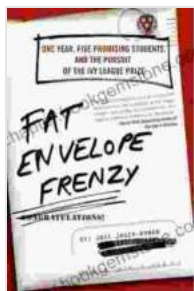

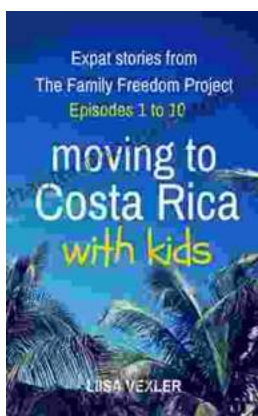
