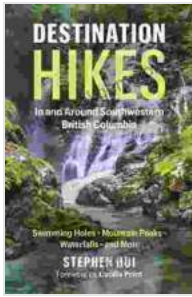

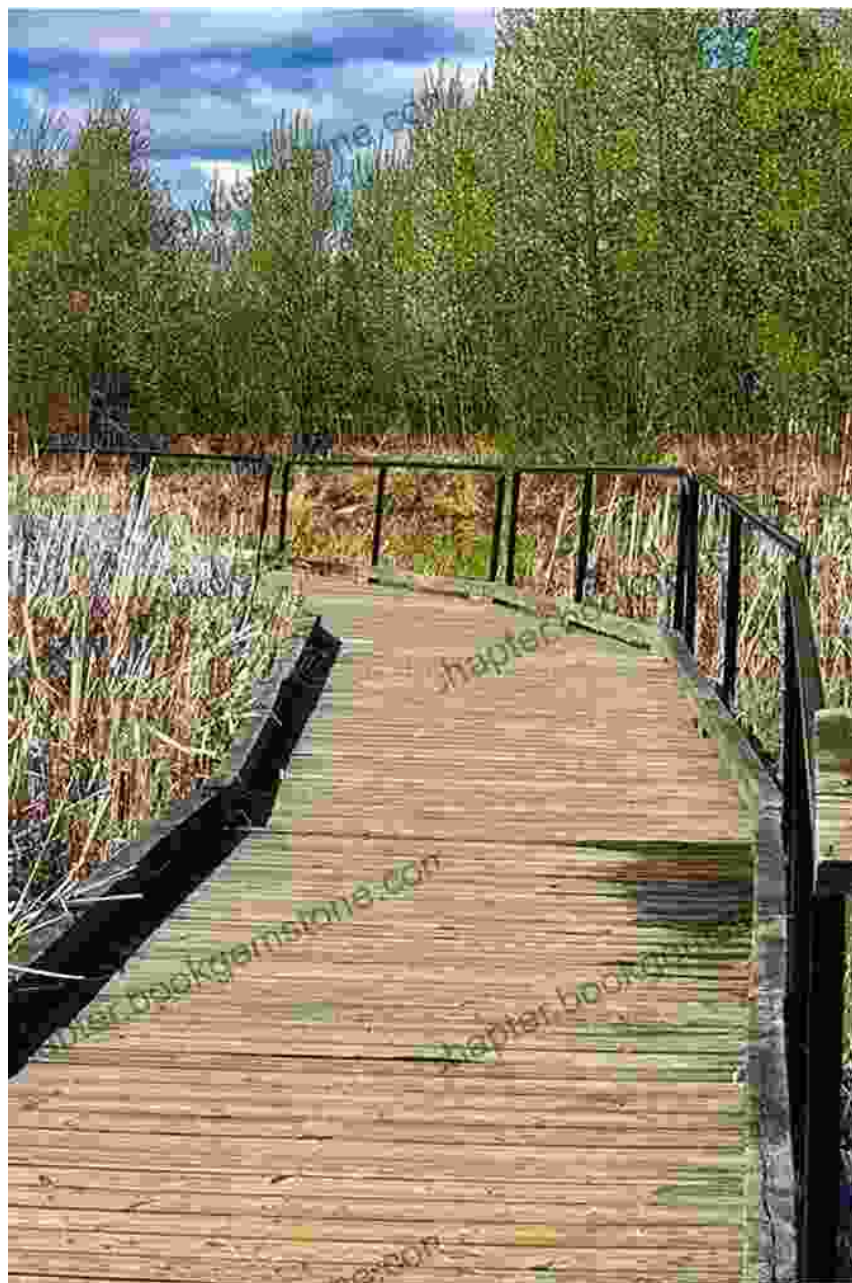
Panorama Ridge Trail

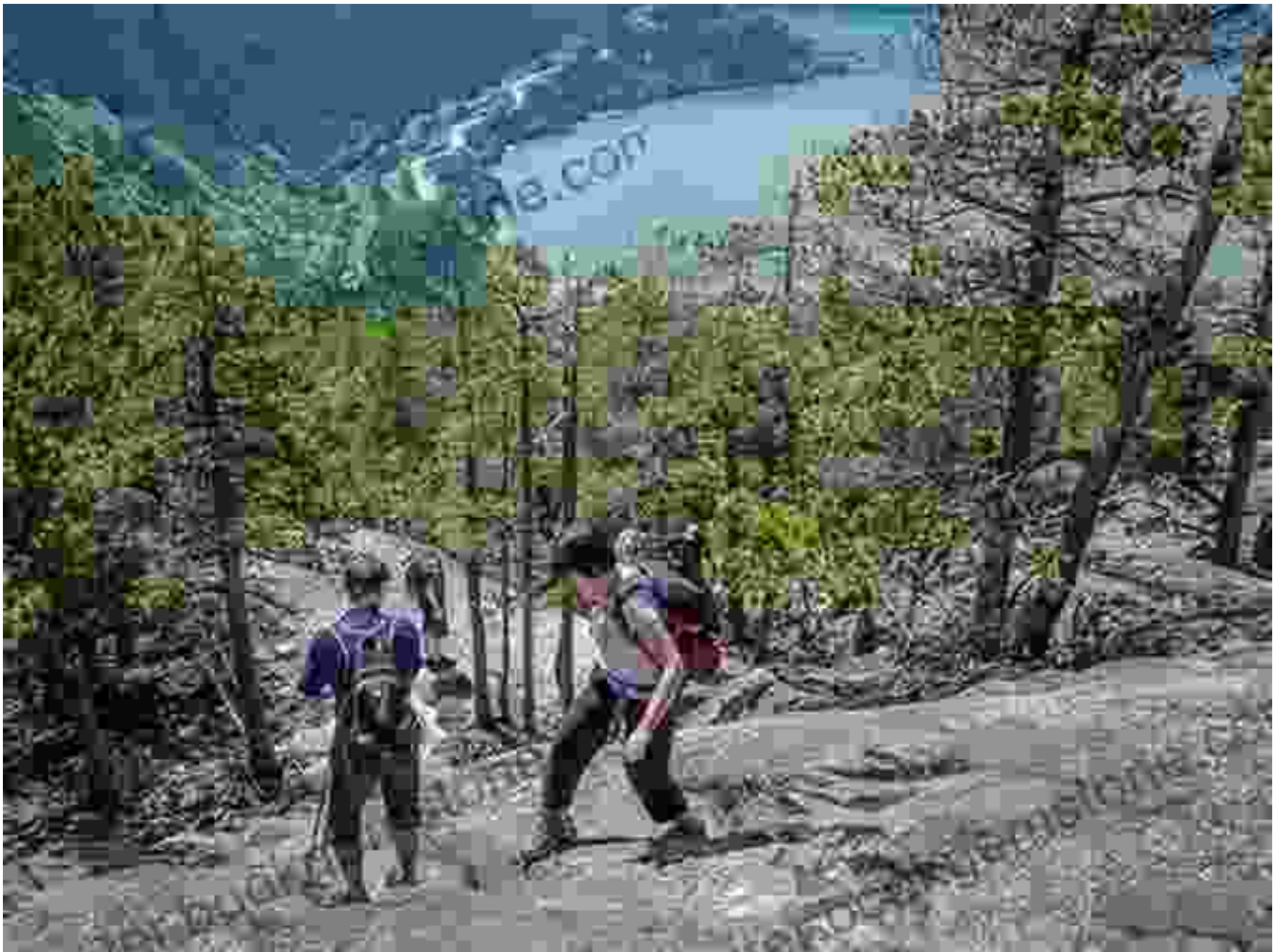

Lions Beak Trail

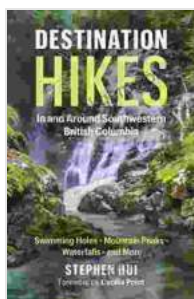

Whistler, famous for its world-class skiing and snowboarding, also offers a variety of hiking trails that cater to all levels



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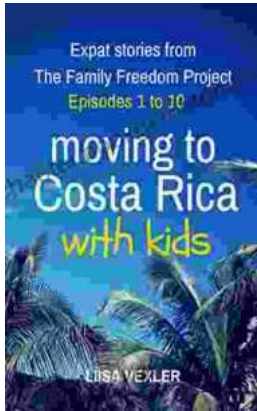
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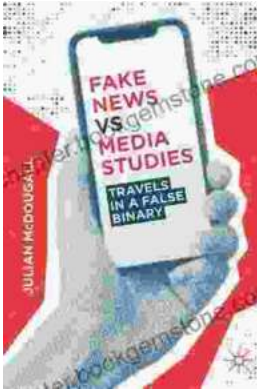
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
